Excerpt from text of Economic Cooperation Agreement
between the United States of America and Portugal.
State Dept. Press Release No. 788, Sept. 29, 1948.

Article X

(Definitions)

As used in this Agreement:

(a) Portugal means the Republic of Portugal (including the Azores Islands and the Madeira Islands) together with dependent areas under its administration, including the Cape Verde Islands, Portuguese Guinea, the fortress of São Joao Baptista de Adjuda, São Tome and Principe, Angola, Mozambique, Portuguese India (comprising Goa, Damão, Diu), Macão and Portuguese Timor.
