<p>[redacted] phoned me concerning his memo of 29 September 1971 and asked me to add a few more remarks to clarify his intent.</p> <p>He asked that I add the following sentence to specify that only the list is to be declassified and that the documents remain classified: As indicated in our previous instructions, the documents themselves remain classified but we will review the documents individually for declassification upon request for their particular utilization.</p> <p>I assured [redacted] I would add this to my reply to the JFK Library.</p> <p>I also raised these questions: What about the Agency Office of Security and DDP/CI as well as the originating offices of the documents on the list? Did he coordinate with them? He said all the documents were from DDI components originally except for OCI. He said the DDI Security Officer was in on the coordination. [redacted] said the DDI himself was involved in the review and approved the declassification of the list.</p> <p>I told [redacted] about the recent concern the DCI expressed over release of OSS documents and the White House plans for [redacted] (over)</p>

greater declassification and that the DCI has asked [redacted] in O/Security to study that problem.

[redacted] said he was familiar with these recent developments but that he was certain the coordination completed in the

Office of the DDI was sufficient. He said he would discuss the matter with [redacted] in O/DDI but unless he called

back soon today's added sentence would be the only change or clarification for his memo and I could proceed with my response to the JFK Library.
