EDITORIAL BRANCH PUBLICAPIONS

1. General

- a. The following arrangements are agreed to in order to insure rapid and efficient production and distribution of FRID Editorial Branch publientions without overtaxing Printing Services Division facilities.
- b. This agreement supersedes all previous agreements and memoranda relative to the production of FRID Miterial Branch reports and publications.
- o. The agreement shall be effective for three years beginning I Jammery 1965, but may be revised in the meantime by mutual consent should either party be forced by unusual circumstances to alter significantly its present level of operation.

2. Daily Reports

HANNESS THAN

- a. Offset masters will be delivered by FRID to the FRD printing plant no later than 1600 hours each day.
- b. The offset masters will be printed by PSD during the evening shift and delivered to communers at the exclient practicable hour the following morning.
- e. The total number of printed pages of the five daily reports shall not exceed 340, including contents pages but excluding covers. (This total includes the White book.) No book shall exceed 95 pages including covers.
- d. The number of copies printed of each book shall not exceed:

(1)	Fer East,	775
(2)	Letin America,	550
(2) (3)	USSR & East Burope,	825
(4)	Middle East, Africa & West Europe,	675
(5)	Fereign Radio Brondensts (White Book),	_725
	Total	3550

In the event it becomes necessary to increase the overall number of Daily Report copies beyond the total indicated above, the maximum number (2 c above) of pages for all Daily Reports will be reduced by four for each ten percent increase in number of copies.

- e. In exceptional circumstances, dictated by major international developments, the total number of pages may exceed 500 and run to 360. In such cases of hos errangements for printing will be made between FRID and PRD at the beginning of the working day.
- 3. When it is necessary to print a Supplement or a World Reaction Report along with the Daily Reports, the number of pages of the Supplement or World Reaction Report is to be included in the maximum number of pages mentioned in paragraph 2 c and c above.
- A maximum of 900 offset masters of Recommic, Technical, and Georgraphic Abstracts (two per master) will be delivered to PED each week. These will be produced within one week and distributed by PSD within ten days of receipt.
