

1. Unless considered absolutely necessary for reasons of high policy, attached document will produce highly undesirable effects in the field, particularly India-Burma.

2. Effect will be to make detachment commanders and intelligence officers feel that they smat yield to all JICA demands, whether justified or not.

3. Statement on page 2, paragraph 2 that JICA is the normal channel for conveying intelligence to the Theater Commander seems particularly injudicious and goes beyond anything that JICA itself has ever suggested, at least in our theater. Are we now supposed to anticipate JICA's desires and offer to satisfy them before they are even formulated?

4. Emphasis on number of reports OSS receives from JICA seems to Indicate a willingness to sacrifice the collecting branches of OSS to the needs of Ball, in my opinion an unnecessary and undesirable policy.
