- Reference your memorendum dated 6 November 1951, same subject, this is to advise that T& is conducting a special training and indoctrination course for newly recruited investigators.
- 2. The objective of the ISS Special Training & Indoctriaation Course is to give a brief indoctrination in the functions and responsibilities of CIA and of Too, and basic training in the techniques of investigation as they apply to work performed by Iks investigators. This is done in order that new men may assume simple investigative tasks immediately upon their assignments tion of the training course is three weeks and it has been given at five week intervals since the middle of May 1951. About 30 persons from IkS and three from other offices are used as lecturers. A total of 87 students or an average of about 17 in each group have subended the course. A copy of the schedule is attached.

With respect to the Administrative Officer Program, 165 would like to take advantage of whatever specialized training is conceived for Administrative Officers presently on duty, but is not in a position to effer any support to the program with respect to furnishing of instructors or background material.
