I. INDOCTRINATION

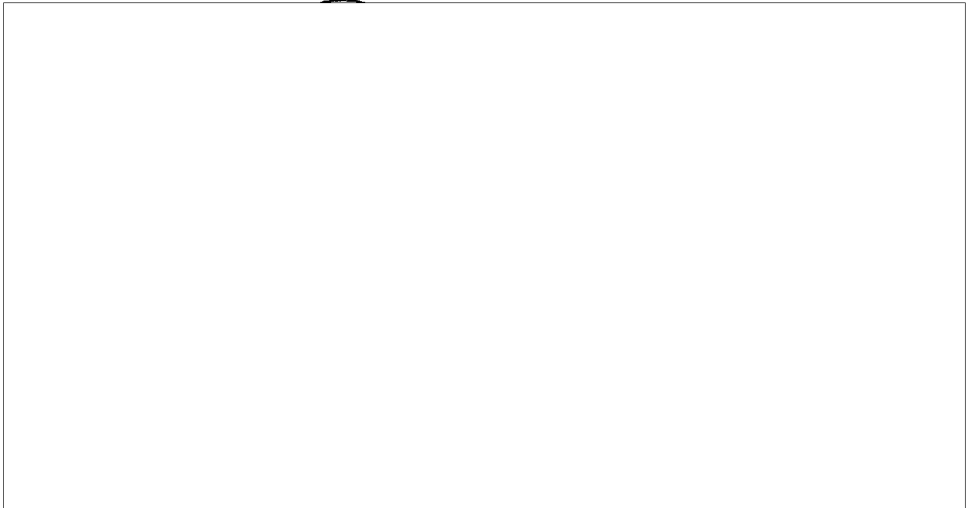
