MEMORANDUM FOR: PHOJECT DIRECTOR

SUMPECT

: Film Requirements for Project AQUATONE

1. In establishing the initial film requirement for Project AQUATONE several factors have been considered in arriving at a safe and realistic recommendation. Some of these factors may be recognized as facts and some must be recognized as assumptions.

- A. Those recognised as facts are:
- (1) The manufacturer requires 2 months "lead time" to manufacture the film.
- (2) The shelf life of the film allows long time storage.
- (3) The film requirement for the "C" camera and the HRR camera will be established at a later date.
- (4) The film requirement for training will be considered separately.
- (5) Initial over-stocking, if any, may be reduced by supplying detachments "B" and "C" from existing stock.
- B. The assumptions that have been considered in establishing this requirement are:
  - (1) 4 sircraft per detachment
  - (2) 32 photographic sorties per detachment per menth
  - (3) 2 months film supply is desired as the initial operating level for one detachment.
  - (4) 3 months film supply is desired as the initial stock level required at the fastery.
- (5) Detachment "A"s" film requirements, for the first two worths, may be adaquately covered by assuming that called will be not more than:
