1. It is recommended that OCI approval be granted to supplement Froject AAATOME 1956 FT money from \$15,800,000 to \$19,605,000, or a net increase of (3,60%,000, to permit the execution of centrasts prior to 30 June 1936, which are essential to the continued operation of the project.

- 2. As you are swere the project, for the most part, was to perform a mission with equipments still in the research and development stages and while we had cotimates from our suppliers indicating their best thoughts concerning the costs of manufacturing several setbacks have been encountered which resulted in expending considerably more than originally contemplated. For example the highly specialized communication goer and ELIST equipment it was thought could be menufactured at a cost of #3,750,000, whereas these equipments are now costing us \$6,969,939, thereby precluding us from ordering necessary film and other essential items unless supplemental funds are made available. The funds requested would be stilized for the purpose and in the amounts stated as fellows:
  - (a) Film, including the costs of chema-\$2,296,911.00 cals and paper for deplicates
  - (b) Additional costs come goar and SLIET equipment (included in the 88,969,939 figure above)
