Determining factor	Map Branch	Reference Center <i>MD</i>
1. Geographic Location	<p>1. Map Library being physically close to Map Branch would eliminate the following problems:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. Frequent physical movement of bulky maps from one area to the other.</li> <li>b. Providing space in Map Intelligence Div. and Cartography Div. to house maps on loan.</li> <li>c. Depletion of Map Library while materials are held in divisions of Map Branch.</li> <li>d. Tendency to build miniature libraries in Cartography and Map Intelligence Div. for materials frequently used.</li> </ul>	<p>1. Reference Center could give speedier service on subject-matter requests..</p>
2. Procedures employed	<p>2.a. Informal direct contact between <sup>present</sup> requester and supplier is the speediest and simplest type of procedure.</p> <p>b. Since Map Intelligence and Cartography Div. of Map Branch have greatest need and are most frequent users of Map Library, they need direct access to Map Library.</p>	<p>2.a. More effective control can be maintained over services supplied.</p> <p>b. Standardized procedures for loan of all Reference materials will make job easier for requester and will permit economies, e.g., reduce forms and controls used.</p>

(1) More easily coordinated with other divisions of Map Branch.</p> <p>(2) Have State Dept. facilities working specifically for them.</p>	<p>a. (1) Can be coordinated with other Reference Center procurement.</p> <p>(2) New sources may come to light through other Reference Center activities.</p> <p>b. (1) Use of standard CIA procedure may save personnel thru volume created.</p>
