By the Presidential Directive of April 4, 1951, to the Secretary of State, the Secretary of Defense and the Director 25X1A of Central Intelligence, there was established the Psychological Strategy Board and, under the Board, a Director to be designated by the President and to receive compensation at the rate of \$16.000.00 per year. The President has now designated to be the Director and Management entered on duty on 2 July.

In order that the may properly perform his duties as Director and organise his staff, it will be necessary for the Departments of State and Defense and the Central Intelligence Agency to afford him and his staff certain administrative support. Those Departments and the Central Intelligence Agency will arrange among themselves, with the approval of the Bureau of the Budget, for effective support as requested by 25X1A In accordance with the President's instructions it is specifically requested that the Central Intelligence Agency undertake the necessary appointment action to regularise duty as of 2 July, to continue necessary personnel actions in connection with the position of Director of the Board and to pay the Director's compensation at the rate of \$16,000.00 per year commencing with the effective date of his entrance on duty.

In the event that make desires to appoint a Deputy Director to assist him in the performance of his functions, it is requested that the Central Intelligence Agency undertake to give similar administrative support to the Deputy Director and pay his compensation at a rate not to exceed \$11,000.00 per year.
