Hardes all Congressional correspondence relating to the interviewing and processing of applicants for employment with CIA who are
referred by members of Congress, informing the interested member of
the outcome in each case.

Cooperates with the Assistant General Counsel responsible for Office of Special Operations legal matters dealing with problems and projects which require mutual understanding and action.

Responsible for organizing testimony for presentation by the Director before the Congress, Congressional committees, Bureau of the Budget, and other appropriate agencies, in connection with legislation or coordination of intelligence functions in which the Central Intelligence Agency is interested, and makes all necessary arrangements for the appearance of Central Intelligence Agency witnesses as deemed appropriate. Also collates material for such other statements or classified lectures and articles as are necessary for the Director to make.

Responsible for performing such other legal and liaison activities in connection with CIA activities as the General Counsel may direct; serves as special representative of the General Counsel in meetings, conferences, and committees where over-all Agency problems are involved.
