SUBJECT: Attached Memoranda Re: Home Leave and Dependency and Residence Reports

1. In accordance with our conversation, there are transmitted herewith memoranda dated April 11 and April 21, 1952, from the Chief, Finance Division, raising questions regarding the granting of home leave to employees in connection with a permanent change of station to a post in the U. S. and regarding permitting individuals to file Dependency and Residence Reports to change their places of residence for home leave and other purposes.

2. Since the questions raised involve points of legal interpretation of laws and regulations, we should appreciate receiving the opinion of your office on these points.

3. Your attention is invited to two recent decisions of the Comptroller General, B-107142 dated 3 March 1952, and B-103478 dated 3 April 1952, which may have a bearing on the queries raised in the attached memoranda.
