Information received from a study of similar problems in the European area indicates that claims arising out of accidents involving vehicles has been handled satisfactorily at the local level in In consequence, pending a report from the Support Staff, FE, it is believed that any contact through the Pentagon may be premature and not necessarily helpful. 	3. With regard to Agency policy concerning the protection of employees from legal claims arising out of the negligent acts of the employee, Congress has guarded jealously the right to pay foreign claims and has granted this power only to certain specified agencies for strictly limited purposes. No such power has been extended to this Agency. However, under the broad powers granted this Agency, where security considerations are controlling, GIA regulations provide that this headquarters is authorized to adjust, determine, make final settlements and authorize payment of claims arising from the negligence of field employees outside the continental United States. Settlement and payment may be made directly by this organization, or for security purposes, through the appropriate agency involved. Such an agency may be either reimbursed or paid in advance. However, investigation and processing of the claim should be made by the appropriate agency and the final liquidated amount of settlement should submitted to the appropriate assistant director of this headquarters for approval. In consequence, the Agency may assume liability and protection of the individual against legal claims in the first instanted association occurred in the course of employment and there are special aspects of a confidential nature which go to the actual basing of operations.	h inc
