If it appears to him to be expedient in the public interest a Becretary of State may, by warrant under his hand, require any person who owns or controls any telegraphic cable or wire or any apparatus for wireless telegraphy, used for the sending or receipt of telegrams to or from any place out of the United Kingdom, to produce to him or to any person named in the warrant the originals and transcripts, either of all telegrams or of telegrams of any specified class or description, or of telegrams sent from or addressed to any specified person or place, sent or received to or from any place out of the United Kingdom by means of any such cable, wire, or apparatus, and all other papers relating to any such telegram.
