1. I was requested to interview [REDACTED] by a lawyer acquaintance, [REDACTED], whose letter is attached. (I have acknowledged this letter.) Incidentally, this letter was given to [REDACTED] unsealed and delivered to me by her. She is quite personable with a pleasant personality, and she talks rather well but she talks. Mainly her conversation was about the high-ranking Generals and VIPs to whom she had been confidential secretary. Some of these have written her letters of appreciation, which are with her file.

2. She also mentioned that she knew Mr. James Garrison and [REDACTED] of this Agency. I have talked to both of them, and they know of her but say they are not in a position to make any comment on qualifications or character. She apparently has been very unhappy in her recent job and has submitted her resignation, effective 23 October 1953. According to [REDACTED] her troubles stem from her feeling that the other girls in the office advance themselves at her expense by using extracurricular time and activities to curry favor with their officer bosses.

3. She hopes for a secretarial job and is presently at the top of a GS-5, but states that she will "take anything" in the way of a job to transfer from Defense to this Agency. As another reference she mentioned Brigadier General Louis Fortier, Retired, but I have not called him.
