Administrative Regulations Regarding Shipment of	Household Goods

1. The new policy, to be contained in forthcoming field regulations, regarding shipment of household goods and personal effects of personnel transferred to and/or from a permanent post of duty abroad which is in an emergency area where furnished quarters are provided is as follows:

Ref: Dir 15234 (OUT 72645) and DIR 16524 (OUT 75122)

a. The maximum amount of household goods and personal effects an employee may transport to and/or from a permanent post of duty abroad which is in an emergency area where furnished quarters are provided shall be determined by his General Schedule grade (or equivalent) and family status in accordance with the following table.

## Exceptions:

When it is determined by Senior Representatives, Chiefs of Missions, Chiefs of Stations, or other officials reporting directly to Meadquarters that in the interest of security and their operations it is necessary to apply to the individual, the rules, regulations, and policies of the organization or establishment which is the "cover" for the individual, amounts of household goods and personal effects commensurate with the weight allowance of the individual's cover organization may be authorized provided the shipment is made through cover channels.
