The reason for limiting shipments to 3,000 pounds under the circumstances outlined above was that the Agency would be providing government-owned furniture and it was felt that the 3,000 pounds allowance would adequately serve the purpose of allowing the individual to give his quarters a more comfortable and personal touch. In this manner, the government would not be put to the expense of shipping full weight allowances to and from overseas areas in addition to the expense in purchasing furniture to be provided in quarters. 25X1
6. a. This Office concurs in amendment of as follows:
"Employees will be authorised to return to the United States those amounts of household goods and personal effects which they were properly authorised to ship to the overseas area; provided the total amount to be returned plus any amounts in storage at government expense does not exceed the employee's over-all weight allowances. In the event that changes in allowances of household goods and personal effects are made, personnel in overseas areas shall be authorised to return to the United States the new allowances in those instances wherein the new allowances are greater than the previous ones."
b. For the reasons outlined in paragraphs 1 through 5 above, this Office does not consur in an amendment to 25X1 4 April 1955, which would retroactively authorize return shipments to the United States in excess of 3,000 pounds when Agency quarters were furnished with Agency procured furniture in emergency areas during the period 3 March 1953 through 27 November 1953.
