Thank you for your letter dated 27 August 1952 in which you state that if after the transmission lines are built our monitoring station has not been moved, your Department will promptly take such action as is justified at the time to correct detrimental interference caused by your transmission lines.

On the basis of your assurance we have this date advised the Los Angeles City Council that our previous objections to the overhead construction of the high voltage power lines in the vicinity of the Foreign Broadcast Information Service monitoring station at Reseda as expressed in our letter to them dated 20 March 1952 are withdrawn.
