MEMORANDUM FOR: Chief, FE

SUBJECT: [REDACTED] - Travel Order FE-814-56 25X1A9a

1. Subject has been in the field continuously for eight years. He is one of those persons who was caught abroad with a weight of household effects in excess of that now authorized for shipment by persons occupying furnished Government quarters. In addition, he occupied unfurnished Government quarters throughout his tour.

2. In the present rewriting of the travel regulations, a savings clause is being inserted for the purpose of avoiding undue personal hardship and financial loss to persons in subject's circumstances. Since the new regulations have not as yet been published, I approve the shipment by subject of household and personal effects, not to exceed 15,000 pounds, from [REDACTED] to Washington, D. C., under the authority granted me by [REDACTED]
