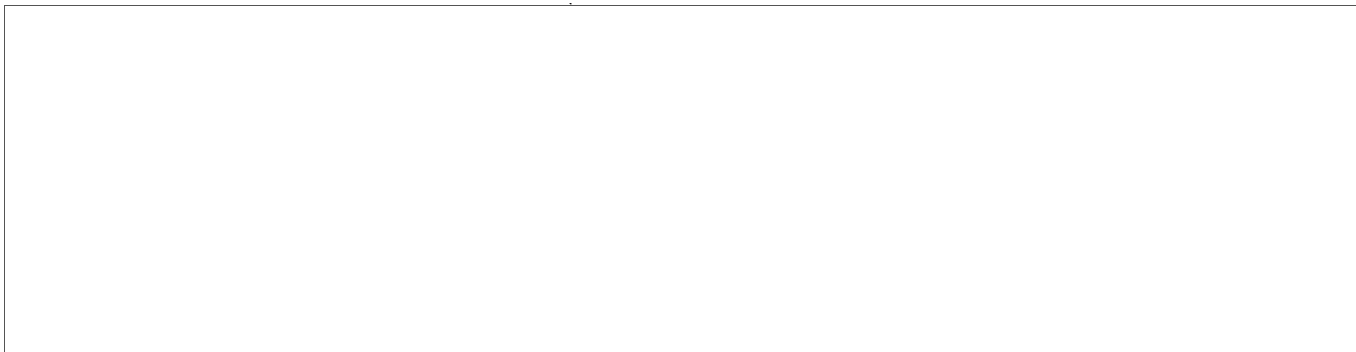

2. Ralph Preston on the staff of House Appropriations telephoned to advise that he had received word Mahon left Rome on the 12th going to Paris. He leaves there on the 14th to take the Queen Elizabeth returning to the U. S. Sam Crosby is going on to Naples, then London on the 14th or 15th and flying back.

3. [redacted] Executive Officer, OSI, called to offer his assistance in briefing Senator Humphrey (D., Minn.) on scientific exchange programs in the field if we desired.
