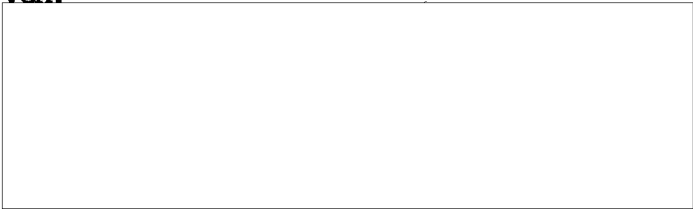
25X1 1. At the request of Major Warrick of the Air Force,
