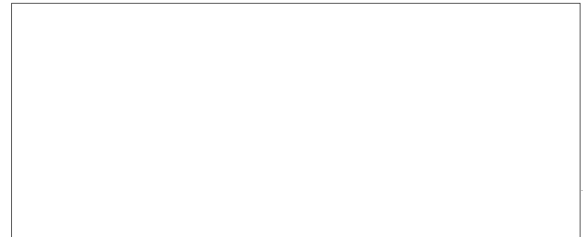
B. OTHER ACTIVITIES

1. Two meetings of the sub-committee drafting recommendations for the DTR on training in Personal Effectiveness Abroad have been held. Both were extremely profitable. There is a general agreement both on form and content of a proposed introductory course and concrete recommendations are now in the process of preparation. The sub-committee consists of [redacted] [redacted] with Hussey acting as chairman. [redacted] will join the group on his return from leave.

2. A total of over 3000 tests have now been given since 2 May 1957 (when the present numbering system was started).

3. Seventy-eight people reported for Proficiency Tests last week in Italian, Japanese, German, Norwegian, Serbian, French, Bulgarian, Spanish and Portuguese.

4. One hundred and thirty-nine Certifications for Language Award certificates were sent to the Registrar last week.



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
