A. SIGNIFICANT ITEMS

B. OTHER ACTIVITIES

1. The major activity of the week is the [redacted] visit by participants in the Overseas Effectiveness course. [redacted] of LAS are participating. [redacted] will join the group on Thursday.

2. [redacted] met with Mr. Karamessines to arrange tutorial training for him before his departure. It was agreed that LAS would provide a list of candidates from our VLTP roster and that Mr. Karamessines would arrange to obtain the services of one instructor during duty hours. The instructor list has been forwarded and we will work out a study plan with the instructor when he is selected.

3. Four students from the VLTP French Seminar spent the weekend at [redacted] with four VLTP instructors and a French-speaking wife of one of them. Two more instructors and [redacted] joined the group for the full day Saturday. Since two instructors are native in proficiency and all the students are Intermediate or High on the Agency Proficiency Test scores the weekend was the best ever experienced in the VLTP.

- Russian Familiarization

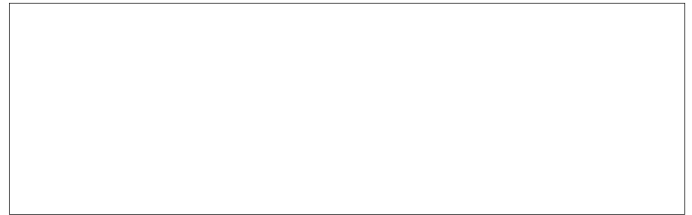
