A. SIGNIFICANT ITEMS

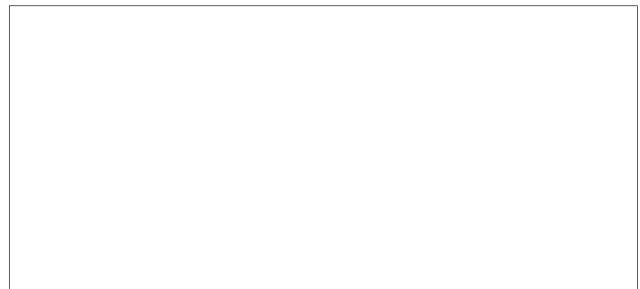
None to report.
