A. SIGNIFICANT ITEMS

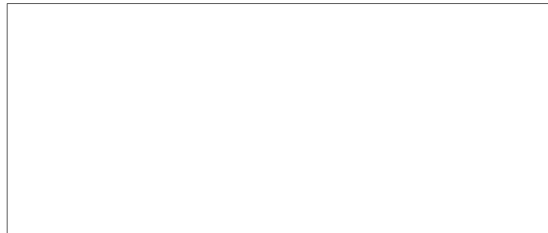
