- (4) The Clandestine Services is continuing excellent support by transferring capable people to the Office of Training for regular tours of duty. The caliber of people assigned is evidenced by the fact that at present, there are nine former Chiefs of Clandestine Services field stations or bases on duty as members of the Operations School.
- (5) An additional list authorizing \$10,850 in language development awards has been forwarded to the Comptroller. The total to date is \$61,975 awarded to 546 Agency employees.
- (6) In the future, the use of the for voluntary language classes will be at the personal expense of the trainees. All will pay for their own travel and subsistence.

(7) Oral language examinations have been recently conducted in French, German, Spanish, Italian, Russian, Polish, Finnish, Chinese and Japanese languages. Of the original group of 850 individuals to be tested in claimed language proficiency, only 125 remain. Of this number 30 will be tested in the next few weeks in languages such as Thai, Indonesian, Persian, Arabic, Bulgarian and Serbo-Croatian.

c. Monthly Enrollment

During the month of August 369 persons were enrolled in OTR conducted courses.
