(5) Cai. Nichols, Chief of the Intelligence Division, Armed Forces Staff College, visited the Agency to discuss their curriculum for FY 1959. The joint OSW/DA-CIA presentation has been so favorably received by the College that additional time has been set aside for this block of instruction. It is now planned that a speaker from the JSAG/JCS will be added to the panel to discuss the employment of psychological warfare. Subsequent arrangements will be made to bring the speakers together in order to coordinate the presentations of the panel.

b. Internal Training Activities

(1) With the assistance of the Chief, Military Personnel Division, approval has been obtained from the Department of the Army and the Department of the Air Force to place Agency reserve officers on two-week periods of active duty as students in selected formal training programs conducted by the Office of Training. These programs are: War Plans Course,

These training programs will augment the active duty training opportunities now available to CIA reservists and will benefit the Services and the Agency by providing the reservists with training, in depth, for his mobilization assignments.

(2) The Winter trimester of the Voluntary Language Training Program ended during the reporting period. Of the 341 students enrolled, 245 completed their classes. By comparison with student participation in the two previous trimesters, this represents a 25% increase in the number who finished the trimester course.
