SUBJECT

: Recording Device to Document Hlind Air Drops

- 1. A recording device is required to substantiate crew claims of successful airdrops on specific points in remote areas.
- 2. Since C-54's, C-118 and C-130 aircraft have radar navigational equipment aboard, the logical solution lies in a camera recording device similar to an O-15 camera presently used for a similar passes by Air Force SAC crews.
- 3. The number desired would be in the order of two for Far East area and two for the Eglin AFB unit. It is recommended that they be transferable between aircraft.
