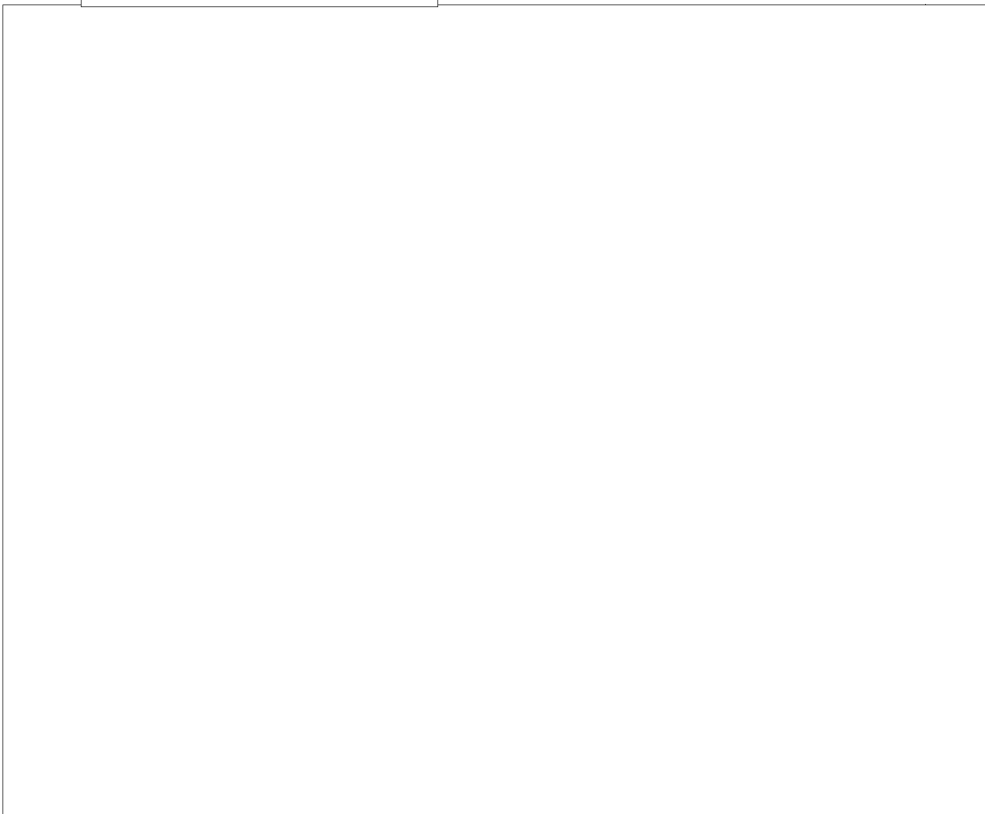
1. In accordance with reference B, the boundaries of the areas along with their respective coordinates, in which it is desired to conduct low level training flights are indicated on the attached Navigation Charts (JN 29-478).

2. All low level operations will be flown at altitudes under 1000 feet above terrain and only under VFR conditions. Flight plans will require that all danger areas, towns of any size, and airport control areas be avoided. Flights will be confined to the areas authorized and any deviation will require prior concurrence of your office.

3. Authorization is requested to conduct low level flights within the confines of the three respective areas shown with coordinates on the charts, and listed under Tab A. Individual routes have not been indicated, nor requested, as it is contemplated that on occasion the planning and evaluation of routes will be part of the training program, and it is considered that the crew derives little benefit after the same route is re-flown on more than two occasions.

b. Operations Area #2 for Aircraft Based at Eglin Air Force Base, Florida:

Routes will be planned and operations conducted under the conditions prescribed in paragraph a. Overwater operations over the Gulf of Mexico and coastal areas will be restricted to the corridors and entry points, respectively, as indicated on JR-45H.

c. (Alternate) Operations Area #1 for Aircraft Based at Eglin Air Force Base, Florida, but Staging Area Based Air Force Base, California:

The basis for this selection of area is in the terrain conditions which closely approximate planned or contemplated

operational requirements in the field. East-west boundaries have purposely been restricted in an attempt to confine the airspace requested within an area which would not conflict with the two major airway arteries running North-South.
