MEMORANDUM FOR: Chief, Medical Staff

SUBJECT : Immunization of Staff and Detailed Personnel at Eglin Air Force Base, Florida

REFERENCE : Memorandum, Same Subject, DPD 7716-59, dated 9 November 1959

1. Reference is made to telephone conversation with [redacted] relative to above subject. [redacted] requested that we procure from our Eglin Detachment a recapitulation of existing immunization records in order to enable the medical staff to determine amount and types of serum needed. This recapitulation is attached.

2. It appears from a check of the list that nearly all the Detachment personnel are in need of the full series. Of the 48 personnel present for duty at the time the list was drawn up, the following shots were required:

Small Pox	46	Typhoid	43
Cholera	41	Tetanus	46
Yellow Fever	20	Typhus	44

These figures are based on the Agency six-month requirement (except Yellow Fever).

3. Based on above figures, it is suggested that the medical personnel assigned to give the immunizations be prepared to provide a full series for the number on duty. In view of the fact that the vacancies on the Table of Organization are rapidly being filled, this number increases weekly. For use as a planning factor, it is estimated that on 1 January there will be a total of 57, on 15 January a total of 72.

4. It is requested that the Medical Staff advise the estimated date that a technician will be available. For further information and arrangements please contact [redacted] on extension [redacted]
