Requirement on Aircraft Accessory Plants in Prague/Holesovice

- 1. It is requested that the following requirement be forwarded to AFOIN 3 for action.
- 2. In the files of the Industrial Register, CCR, there are three national enterprises (narodni podnik) listed as manufacturers of aircraft accessories and missiles guidance systems in Prague/ Holesovice, Czechoslovakia. The first is the FAL enterprise, yet, this enterprise has 25X1X1 according to only one plant which is in Kbely, a northeastern suburb of Prague, and none in Holesovice. The second is known as the Rudy Letov III plant. According to the more reliable information available, the Rudy Letov national enterprise was a manufacturer of aircraft whose name, in about 1953-5h, was changed to Letnanske Strojirny. This latter having one plant in Letnany, a northeastern suburb of Frague, and recent reports indicate its activities to be the assembly of airframes. The third national enterprise is Elecktrosignal:

3. From the information on file in the IR it is possible to arrive at the existence of three fairly distinct installations:

The first is cited by reports as being located in the buildings of the former Prague exhibition halls on U Kralovska obory. However, all these reports refer to this installation by the name, Mudy Letov III. As has been mentioned above, Rudy Letov no longer exists as a combine, and the listing for its successor makes no mention of a plant in Holesovice. However, the address given above for the main plant of Elecktrosignal is approximately that of the Prague exhibition halls. Are production activities taking place in these former exhibition halls, are any products discernible, and to which national enterprise does this facility belong?

h. The second confirmed installation was known by the name of the Hodek Plant which manufactured aircraft accessories before and during world War II. The plant was nationalized, presumably, to become a part of the PAL Motor Vehicle and Aircraft Parts Enterprise. This specific part of the installation is placed by all sources at 3 or 5 V Zavetri. The last official mention of which cities it this plant is as part of the Aeropal national enterprise, whose main offices

are in Modrany. There is no mention of this installation under Aeropal or any other enterprise, as far as we can determine, Is this plant still in

production, what does it produce, and to which national enterprise does it belong?

5. The third identifiable installation is in the block formed by the following streets in Holesovice: U pruhonu on the North, Usedni on the East, Delnicka on the South, and Argentinska on the West. Current information on file in the IR, labels this facility either as PAL-Holesovice or just plain aircraft or aircraft instruments plant. As has been cited above.
