MEMORANDUM FOR: ACTING DIRECTOR

SUBJECT: NATO Intelligence Organization

1. By memorandum dated 15 December 1950, the U. S. Member, Standing Group Intelligence Committee, requested CIA comments on enclosures covering NATO warning procedure in case of attack and basic NATO intelligence organization.

2. By memorandum dated 15 January 1951, the U. S. Member requested CIA comments on intelligence guidance for the Standing Group and for SHAPE. These comments are in preparation.

3. The following documents are attached:

TAB A - Memorandum for the Deputy Director for Intelligence, the Joint Staff, containing CIA's agreement in principle to the enclosures cited in Paragraph 1 above, and acknowledging the memorandum cited in Paragraph 2 above.
