SUBJECT: Intelligence Deficiencies revealed in SE-27.

1. At a meeting held in my office 13 September 1952, attended by Messers, Nordbeck, State, Becker and [redacted] OGD, Bagwell and [redacted] YED, and [redacted] OGD, reports submitted by these offices were reviewed to develop actions which would improve the indexing, translation, and exploitation of material on Communist China.

2. Based on agreements reached at the meeting, the attached draft memorandum for the DCI and the IAC representatives, in accordance with the DCI's request of 13 August 1952, is prepared in the form of a status report indicating the actions which have been taken to correct present deficiencies in these areas.

3. Please advise if you concur in the action items indicated in the draft memorandum and the designations of the action office.
