MEMORANDUM FOR THE DIRECTOR, CENTRAL INTELLIGENCE AGENCY Subject: Embargo and Blockade Against Communist China.

- 1. The Joint Chiefs of Staff have this date directed me to request the IAC to make a study, as a matter of priority, on the following subject: "Embargo and Blockade Against Communist China."
- 2. It would be most valuable if the following terms of reference could be covered because the U.K. has been requested to make a study along the same lines with the purpose of exchanging U.S.-U.K. intelligence on this subject:
  - a. What is the current status of the implementation of the embargo against Communist China?
  - b. What are the causes of less than 100 per cent implementation?
  - e. What measures might be taken to increase the efficiency of the embargo?
  - d. Estimate the capabilities of an embargo to bring pressure to bear on Communist China.
  - 2. Estimate the capabilities of a sea blockade to increase the pressure on Communist China.
  - f. Estimate the effect of air attacks against rail communications and inland waterways further to increase this pressure.
  - g. Consider measures which the Communists would be likely to take to counter the effects of the actions in  $\underline{d}$ ,  $\underline{e}$ , and  $\underline{f}$ .
- 3. I understand that an estimate covering the first three items. 2 a to 2 c above, is now in preparation on a rush basis. I certainly do not want to make any request that would impinge on such an effort. An expansion of that estimate when completed into one covering items 2 d to 2 f above would meet the Joint Chiefs' needs completely.
