In connection with Mr. Connelly's clearance on 12 December of the draft messages re classification of "Confidential" for EXCON messages (with certain exceptions), he stated that it was his intention to request State to add the following en all despatches or telegrams containing information:

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\*FOR BACKGROUND USE ONLY\*
\*MOFORM\*

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This will insure checking with Washington if

Approval of draft circular instruction and cutgoing airgram to USRO/ST regarding

elassification of CG/COCOM/CHINCOM Documents.

i. The attached drafts of outgoing messages have been received from State/ECD. The messages propose a general rule of "confidential" as the classification for the following types of documents:

COCOM Documents

EDAC Documents

ACEP Decuments

EXCOM Hessages

"Old" International Lists (the revised lists are confidential)

China Special List

- 2. A large proportion of COCOM documents have already been dosagraded to "Confidential" with CIA concurrence. These have been found by review to contain no classified intelligence information.
- 3. Because of stricter regulations set up in 1954 concerning the handling and transmission of Secret material, the State Department considers that there is an operational need in their foreign service posts for use of a classification of "Confidential" (or lower) whenever possible.
- A. A copy of POLTO A-307 is attached for your convenience. The final sentence of also referred to in the draft messages, states: "There will then be a presumption that all EXCON messages meriting classification will be "Confidential" rather than "Secret", subject to exceptional cases where higher classification is warranted".

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5. Your comments or concurrence in the attached drafts is requested. It is further requested that you check with any CIA source office which you believe would be interested in the problem of classification of EXCON communications.
