~~of Soviet use of~~ <sup>attempts to obtain</sup> strategic materials (principally bcras)  
through Yugoslavia? Discuss Yugoslav  
efforts to ~~control such~~ <sup>prevent this</sup>

4. Firms like ~~Chem Remkcalija Zagreb,~~ <sup>Jagorupost Generalpost, and</sup> Hempro, ~~Belgrade,~~ <sup>and</sup> others have been described as "semi-official organs of the Yugoslav government." Discuss the ~~actual~~ <sup>actual</sup> control, if any, exercised by the Yugoslav Government, <sup>and/or the Ministry of Foreign Trade</sup> over these firms. ~~Indicate~~ <sup>are</sup> the ~~propaganda~~ <sup>likelihood</sup> that ~~such firms~~ <sup>are</sup> engaged in illegal trade with ~~the~~ <sup>or</sup> without the knowledge of the Yugoslav Government.

The Yugoslav Chamber of <sup>Commerce</sup> ~~Foreign Trade~~ issues ~~import~~ <sup>end-use</sup> certificates certifying that ~~goods~~ <sup>specific</sup> subject to ~~certain~~ imports will not be reexported without the consent of the exporting Government. Does the~~ Are there any known instances of collusion between foreign trade firms and the Chamber of Commerce and/or the Ministry of Foreign Trade to permit shipments covered by end-use certificates to be on forwarded to the Bloc?
