Two of the former OSS operators in Italy, during World War II, [redacted] have sent to the Consulate General the following telegram dated August 22, 1951:

"Wishing to honor memory of our friend and war comrade Major Holoan we renew our heartfelt sentiments of sorrow.

These Italians have informed the Consulate General orally that they understand a ceremony is to be held shortly in the United States in memory of Major Holoan who was murdered near Milan during the latter part of the war, and they desired to participate in the ceremony by means of the foregoing telegram.
