MEMORANDUM FOR: Director of Training

SUBJECT : U.S. Army Request for Instructions on Dangers of Communism in South and Latin America

1. At the regular weekly meeting between the FI Staff and ACSI on 29 June 1959, the Army orally requested that the Agency give a thorough briefing on the dangers of Communism in Latin America to four U.S. Army officers who will, in the near future, be instructors in the school being established by the U.S. Army in Panama for selected Army officers from the various South and Latin America countries. The Army stated that it now has two officers for such briefing and a third will be available after July 14. The availability of the fourth officer is still indefinite. The Army would like to have this briefing take place as soon as possible, as they will soon begin work on the courses of study for this school and the Army feels that they should have the briefing prior to preparing these courses.

2. of the CI Staff is familiar with the proposed Army school in Panama for Latin American Army officers and of the purposes and needs behind this request. I suggest that appropriate people in training get in direct touch with and between them make the necessary plans for the content of the briefing, and arrange directly with the Army as to the dates.
