RECORD OF DISCUSSION

ON

PROPOSED UNITED KINGDOM EXPORT OF MUSEUM EXHIBITS TO POLAND

28th July 1960

Present: Belgium(Luxembourg), Canada, Denmark, France, Germany, Italy, Japan, United Kingdom, United States.

Reference: COCOM Document 4071.

1. The CHAIRMAN drew the Committee's attention to a Memorandum from the United Kingdom Delegation (COCOM Document 4071) concerning the export of museum exhibits to Poland. He invited Delegates to express their Governments' views.
2. The UNITED STATES Delegate stated that there had been insufficient time for his authorities to complete their study of this case. He was thus without instructions.
3. There were no objections from other Delegations.
4. The CHAIRMAN asked the United States Delegate to be good enough to inform the United Kingdom Delegate of his position as soon as possible and also to notify the Secretariat.
