The same general administrative procedural restrictions exist in travel, where all arrangements are normally made through Central Processing Branch rather than by the people themselves, as we do for our own travelers. Travel orders are subject to full coordination through affected areas of the DD/P. Personnel ceilings for come under DD/P control, which means that Management Staff must approve adding slots, upgrading of existing jobs and the classification of new positions subject to the review of the Position Evaluation Division of the Office of Personnel. In AQUATONE we have not been obliged to have our T/Os reviewed by anyone other than the Deputy Director, Support.

7. There is the matter of communications, where is handled precisely as any other DD/P division activity; i.e., their cables go through the regular Agency channels abroad and usually are subject to a great deal of time-consuming inter-divisional coordination, in addition to which they are not held as closely as AQUATONE messages on receipt overseas.

8. I do not argue that we should remove \_\_\_ from any and all controls now being exercised over their affairs by DD/P. if only because such coordination and exchange of plans is vitally necessary in the conduct of normal mair support missions. I do feel, however, that for projects and special program activity: i.e., you may wish to consider obtaining guarantees that these efforts not be hampered by administrative or operational restrictions that may slow the pace of these activities down to what you have described as "something glacial".

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9. Whether Mr. Wisner would agree to an arrangement where would be run under the "double standard", with one set of rules for normal air support and another for projects and programs, I do not know. But unless there is some latitude in the matters I have enumerated, I foresee stumbling blocks in the road of close coordination of our several activities, and in implementing some of your plans as rapidly as you may wish.
