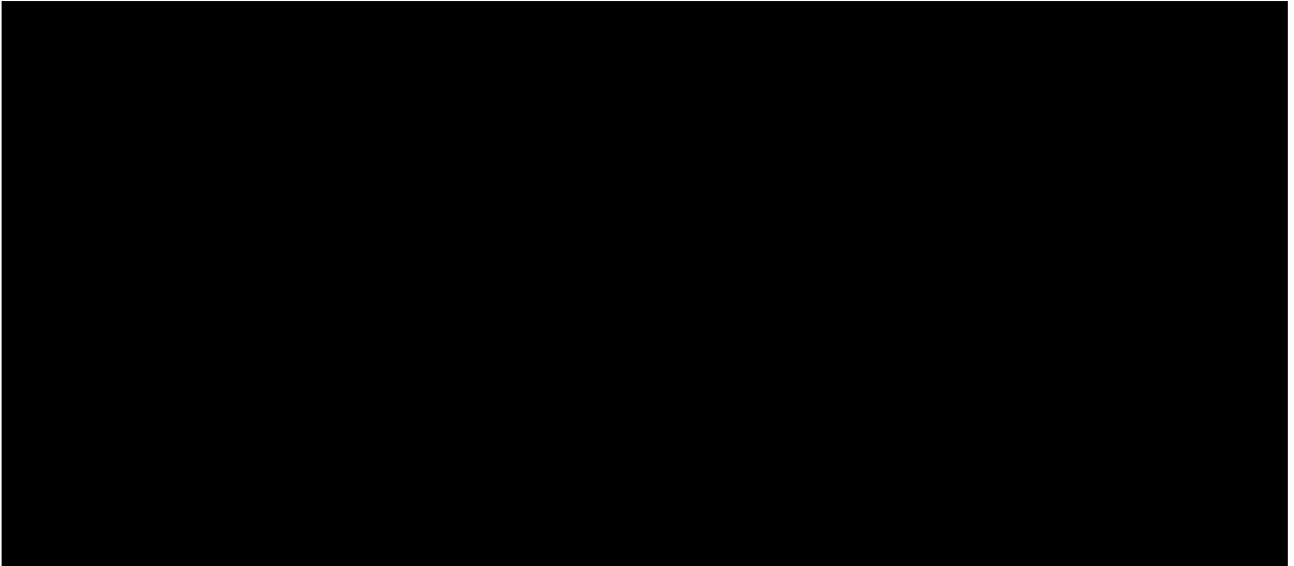
MEMORANDUM FOR: Chief, Geography Division, Research and Reports

SUBJECT : Requirements for Geographic Surveys in Latin America

1. The purpose of this memorandum is to clarify WH requirements for geographic surveys covering selected Latin American countries. Previous correspondence on this subject is hereby rescinded.

2. At the present time there is a need for surveys for the following countries listed in order of priority:
