

CHAPTER III

CENTRAL INTELLIGENCE AGENCY

The committee approves \$49,000,000, the budget estimate and the amount allowed by the House of Representatives for construction of the headquarters for the Central Intelligence Agency. The committee directs that the Agency shall plan to house all headquarters personnel of the Agency within the sum provided. The committee further directs that none of these funds shall be obligated or spent until the Chairman of the National Capital Planning Commission shall certify that written commitments have been obtained from the appropriate local authorities for the financing and construction of roads, sewerage treatment plants, public transport, and other local facilities which are deemed necessary by the Commission to serve the site selected.
