MEMORANDUM FOR THE DIRECTOR OF CENTRAL INTELLIGENCE

SUBJECT: Letter to Mr. Robb Sagendorph, Publisher of Yankee, Incorporated re offer of Censorship records

1. Mr. Alfred McCormack, of State Department, received a letter from Mr. Robb Sagendorph, Publisher of Yankee, Incorporated containing an offer of certain Censorship records which he believes to be of value to censorship planning. Mr. McCormack advised Mr. Sagendorph that he was referring the letter to the Director of Central Intelligence with the suggestion that this office get in touch with him when ready to undertake censorship matters.

2. A study of censorship matters is being undertaken by Central Planning Staff in anticipation of a formal request. A consideration of the problems involved in this study leads to the conclusion that it is advisable to obtain the records offered by Mr. Sagendorph at this time.

3. Action recommended:

That the attached draft of letter to Mr. Sagendorph be approved and dispatched.
