2. The Planning Staff has considered the proposed agreement from the standpoint of content and policy as to need and use by the C.I.G., and is of the opinion that the C.I.G. should adopt the draft submitted by [redacted] and require its use for all personnel performing duties for the C.I.G.

3. In anticipation of the approval and use of the proposed security agreement a provision has been incorporated in a draft C.I.G. Directive, Clearance of Personnel for Duties with the Central [redacted] that each [redacted]
