25X1 1. [redacted] Advised by [redacted] CDC, that 25X1
the State representative had requested, in the IDC meeting this morning,
that any open hearing or release of testimony before Senate Internal 25X1
Security Subcommittee be deferred until [redacted] departure from
the country and that FE Division and CA Staff had agreed to the request.
[redacted] met with Sam Scott, Senate Internal Security Subcom-
mittee staff, and requested that the hearing tentatively scheduled for
testimony of [redacted] be put back from [redacted] until 25X1
[redacted] Mr. Scott indicated this was agreeable, that as
yet he had not been able to locate a Senator on the Subcommittee who
would be available for the hearing on the [redacted] 25X1

25X1 2. [redacted] Returned the transcripts and other
memoranda concerning the 4 October hearing on the Youth Festival to
Mr. Don Appell, House Committee on Un-American Activities staff.
Mr. Appell had departed earlier in the day on a two and a half week vacation.

25X1 3. [redacted] Learned from the Director's office
that the Director saw Senator Hickenlooper at his home last night. The
Senator was preparing to go on a trip so the Director saw him preparatory
to the trip.

25X1 4. [redacted] After discussions with [redacted] advised Miss Duarte 25X1
in the office of Senator Chavez that the Agency had reviewed the papers of
[redacted] and indicated he looked well qualified. In the
meantime, we have referred his name to other organizations and we have
indicates that they will be in touch with [redacted] and may be in a position 25X1
to offer him immediate employment.
