SUBJECT: Visit of Doctors Dorothy Fosdick and Robert Tufts

REF: CA-9208, February 27, 1963; Depcirtel 504, Sept. 21, 1962

Doctors Dorothy Fosdick and Robert Tufts, Staff Members of the Sub-committee of the National Security Staff and Operations of the Senate Committee on Government Operations in Europe and Asia, and Colonel George B. Sloan, representative of the Department of the Army, visited Tehran October 25-27, 1962. The stated purpose of the visit was to make a special study of the operations of the Country Team and related problems of interagency coordination in the field between the representatives of the Departments of State and Defense and other national security agencies.

Enclosed is the itinerary of the group. In addition to the scheduled briefings and discussions, the Staff Members of the sub-committee were afforded and took advantage of ample opportunities for informal discussions with key members of the Country Team and staffs of the agencies in Tehran.

The Embassy believes that the Staff Members were fully satisfied with their visit to Tehran and consider that they have been able to obtain the information and make the observations in which they were interested. This impression is supported by the fact that Senator Jackson wrote the Secretary of the Army a letter stating that the "staff visit to Tehran proved to be one of the most beneficial of the entire trip."

No press releases regarding the visit were issued, and the visit of the group received no particular attention from the local press.
