HOOVER COMMISSION RECOMMENDATIONS ON PERSONNEL AND CIVIL SERVICE

- I. In order to implement certain personnel recommendations of the Roover Commission having to do with the relationship between moncareer political executives and "career administrators" in the Federal Service generally, heads of departments and independent establishments have been directed to prepare and promulgate to their personnel a policy statement which fits their particular situation but definitely carries out the desires of the President and the Hoever Commission recommendations to keep career administrators out of 'political controversies'."
- 2. All personnel are advised that there are no noncareer political executive" positions in the Central Intelligence Agency.
- 3. It is essential that in the course of our work neither the Agency nor its personnel becomes identified with partisan policies, and it is the duty of all personnel to keep out of political controversies.
