House Foreign Affairs Committee staff survey team consisting of Roy J. Bullock, Senior Staff Consultant, Robert F. Brandt, Investigator-Consultant, and Harry C. Cromer, Staff Consultant, are making a study of U. S. assistance programs in Brazil and Peru during August and September and will stop in Panama for several days on the way back to Washington.

General O'Meara is taking care of arrangements for the team's visit to Panama.

For Peru: CODEL was heavily interested in loan implementation. Mr. Brandt exhibited strong interest in major contracts, principally forward funding problems. Mr. Busenberg, now at the Mission, participated in CODEL briefings and can give further information.

For Panama: Enclosed is a copy of a report of House Foreign Affairs survey team, consisting of Mr. Brandt and Mr. Cromer, on "The Housing Investment Guaranty Program and the Economic Aid Program in Panama", November 19, 1963.
