Spy Didn't Work for Us

STOCKHOLM, Sweden, April 11 (UPI)—The U. S. embassy today formally denied reports that Swedish Col. Stig Wennerstroem, confessed spy for Russia, also worked for American intelligence.

Wennerstroem, 57, is on trial behind closed doors in Stockholm after having confessed he spied for the Kremlin for 15. years — five of them as a Swedish air attache in WashingWennerstroem, a distinguished -looking air force staff officer who also served with the Swedish Embassy in Moscow, faces a maximum life prison sentence if convicted of charges that he sold Swedish and North Atlantic Treaty Oraganization defense secrets to the Soviet intelligence service.
