i. In answer to your request, I am forwarding herewith the views of the United States Intelligence Board on the intelligence requirements.

- 2. I am of the opinion that two regularly-scheduled U-2 missions a day designed to cover the Cuban island and flown under predictable weather conditions can satisfy the high-level USIB requirements. If bad weather precludes flying, the postponed missions should be flown later when weather permits and should be in addition to the regularly-scheduled two-a-day.
- 3. It is understood that if it is determined that lowlevel missions are needed in order to satisfy the requirements in paragraph 2 of the enclosed USIB requirements, Presidential authority will be obtained.
